- 1. The organisers, RDA Herts and Essex Border Group, reserve the right to cancel the ride, alter the routes and times and refuse entry without stating the reason.
- 2. Entry fees will be refunded if the organisers cancel the event.
- 3. Entry fees are non-returnable if for any reason the rider fails to start.
- 4. The organisers do not accept any liability whatsoever for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other persons or property.
- 5. Riders under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 6. Riders between the ages of 12 and 16 must have a signed letter of consent from a parent or guardian if riding unaccompanied by an adult.
- 7. No stallions allowed.
- 8. Horses/ponies must be over 4 years of age.
- 9. Hard hats and proper footwear must be worn. Tack and riding clothes will be checked at the start.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to retire any horse/pony that appears in any way unfit or distressed.
- 11. No dogs are allowed.
- 12. RIDERS MUST KEEP TO THE ROUTE AS MARKED
- 13. Riders are responsible for collecting all monies promised and sending them to the organisers.
- 14. Any veterinary expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the horse owner/rider.
- 15. Participants must ride in single file on any public highways, always show courtesy to other road users and comply with any directions given by stewards.
